## LAND UNITS AND MEASUREMENTS

Some commonly used land units and measurements follow.

- A rod is $161 / 2$ feet.
- A chain is 66 feet, or 100 links.
- A mile is 5,280 feet.
- An acre contains 43,560 square feet. Memorize this one.
- A section of land (in the government survey method) is one square mile and contains 640 acres; a quarter section contains 160 acres; a quarter of a quarter section contains 40 acres.
- A circle contains 360 degrees; a quarter segment of a circle contains 90 degrees; a half segment of a circle contains 180 degrees. One degree ( $1^{\circ}$ ) can be subdivided into 60 minutes ( $60^{\prime}$ ), each of which contains 60 seconds (60"). One-and-a-half degrees would be written $1^{\circ} 30$ '0".
