

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENT

Real Estate Salesperson or SLWRERC License Qualification

To obtain a license the candidate must

- be 18 years of age or older;
- prove a high school education or its equivalent;
- furnish evidence of good moral character;
- successfully complete a 75-hour prelicensing course;
- **disclose his or her Social Security number for child support enforcement purposes;**
- provide documentation of citizenship or legal residence in the United States;
- pass a state examination; and
- be sponsored by a licensed real estate broker (to activate the license).
